



Alan R. Lamarche

March 19, 1945 - November 29, 2024

Alan R. Lamarche, 79, of Shell Point, passed away after an extended illness on November 29, 2024. Alan graduated from Florida State University with a B.S in Law Enforcement in 1967 and from Nova University in 1975 with his Master's degree in Criminal Justice Administration. He was the first Florida Wildlife Officer to possess a college degree and the first to graduate from the FBI National Academy (1975). Because of his love of fishing and hunting, Alan served as a Florida Wildlife Officer from 1967 to 1973, was Investigations Supervisor 1973-1977, and served as Assistant Chief of Law Enforcement 1977-1980, when he retired to establish Plantation Security, Inc. and serve as Chief Firearms Instructor at Pat Thomas Law Enforcement Academy until his retirement from the State of Florida in 1997. In addition, Alan represented South Broward High School at Boys State in 1963 and, because of his outstanding speed and talent, he attended Florida State University on a full football scholarship under Coach Bill Peterson 1963-1967. He was a member of the FSU Lettermen's Club and FSU Alumni Association.

He will be remembered by his loving wife of 58 years Kathleen Lamarche, daughter Mary Kate Thompson and husband Todd, 6 grandchildren Daniel, Dalton, Kayla, Tristdan, Miles & Vincent and 2 great grandchildren Robert & Zealynn.

He was preceded in death by his son Daniel Lamarche.
