Altoral "Big Al" Terrell, 47, of Crawfordville went to be with the Lord on Saturday, October 14, 2023 in Tallahassee, Florida; with his family by his side. Al was born in Picayune, MS, but grew up in Ansley, MS. He was a proud graduate of St. Stanislaus Catholic High School, Bay St. Louis, MS. He lived in Crawfordville, FL for the past 8 years with his family. Al was first a man of God. His passion was to disciple and encourage those around him. He was a friend to many and had the gift of building relationships. All that knew Al, knew that he was concerned about their souls and them getting to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Al has served as a licensed ordained minister for over 12 years. He was a current member, pastor and board member at River of Life Church, Crawfordville, FL. He also served as a pastor at Real Life Church in Hattiesburg, MS. He received his Pastoral license from Remnant Church House of Deliverance, New Orleans, LA and a Certificate of Ordination from Hosanna Ministries Inc. of St. Joseph, Missouri.

Al received a Bachelor of Science in Technology from Covenant Bible College and Seminary, Tallahassee, FL. He assisted in the planting of Covenant Bible College and Seminary satellite campus in Picayune, MS, where he also served as an instructor.

Al began his welding profession while attending Pearl River Community College, Poplarville, MS and later attended Lively Technical College, Tallahassee, FL.

His teaching career as a welding instructor at Lively Technical College began in 2015. He was the lead instructor for Rickards High School first welding program and assisted with Wakulla High School's welding program.

Survivors include his wife of 19 years Lena Terrell, his mother Juanita Terrell; five children Vincent R. Faulkner, Jr., Brandon R.
