June 24, 1948 - September 24, 2025

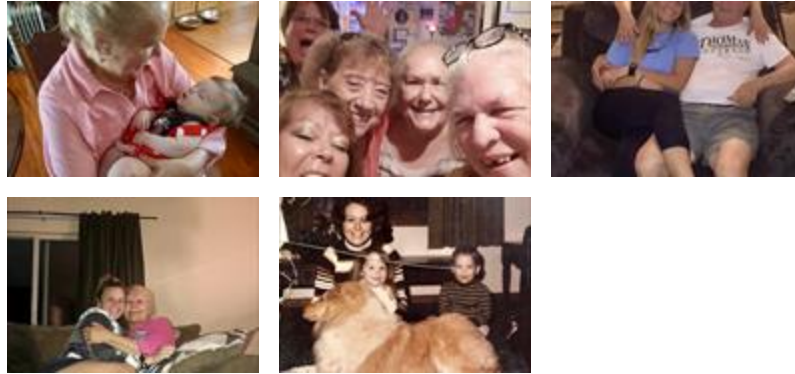

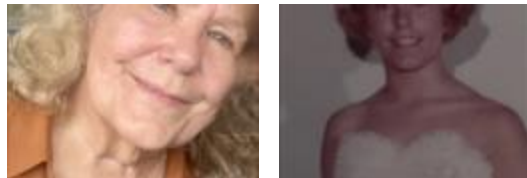
