Anniedia Sue (Yerby) Daws, age 88, of Woodville, Florida, passed away peacefully at home on Monday, May 25, 2026.

Born and raised in Lawton, Oklahoma, Anniedia was the daughter of John and Emily (Gellner) Yerby. It was there that she met the love of her life, William “Bill” Daws, Jr., with whom she shared 66 devoted years of marriage.

Anniedia had a remarkable gift for creativity and craftsmanship. She spent countless hours hand-painting plates, cups, glasses, and pottery, while also creating beautiful quilts, crocheted afghans, handbags, and many other handmade crafts that became treasured keepsakes for family and friends.

She loved going to crafts shows to share her creations with others.

Anniedia and Bill shared a love for adventure and travel as longtime members of the Big Bend Airstream Club for 32 years. Together, they enjoyed camping and exploring destinations ranging from Alaska to Mexico, across the United

States from Florida to California, to the southern Islands via many cruises and abroad to China and South Korea.

A devoted woman of faith, Anniedia was a faithful member of First Baptist Church Woodville (FBCW) for more than 50 years. She loved sharing her time and talents with the various children' activities at FBCW. She loved singing and was a member of the choir for many years. She loved singing specials with Bill and her daughters. She faithfully supported religious and spiritual missions close to her heart and loved sharing the love of Jesus with others. Anniedia was preceded in death by her beloved husband, William "Bill" Daws, Jr., and her sister, Edith Newman.
