Bernard Ardell Browne, 89, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away peacefully in his sleep on October 10, 2025, with his beloved wife by his side as his favorite hospice nurse softly sang “Pass Me Not, O Gentle Savior.”

Born December 28, 1935, to Evie and Myron Browne, Bernard was raised in a home where prayer and faith were the foundation. Even from an early age, it was clear God’s hand was on his life. Though he wandered for a time, the Lord called him back in a powerful way, and Bernard devoted himself to ministry for more than 50 years.

In 1954, he married the love of his life, Dessie, and together they shared 70 wonderful years of marriage, raising their daughters Becky and Ginger, along with their dearly loved bonus daughter, Judy Ruiz. They built a family rooted in love, faith, and service, later being blessed with grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and even great-great-grandchildren who were his pride and joy.

Bernard’s life was defined by his unwavering love for God and his deep desire to share the message of salvation. Whether preaching from a pulpit, ministering in tents and small buildings, or traveling across the world to plant churches, he never missed an opportunity to point others to Jesus. For Bernard, both the outdoors and the church were places where he felt close to the Lord.

He also carried the message of Christ to the nations, preaching and helping build churches in Mexico, Bolivia, Peru, the Philippines, Russia, Rwanda, and Nairobi. His legacy is one of obedience, faithfulness, and countless souls brought to Christ through his ministry.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Evie and Myron Browne; sisters, Myra Jean (Crawford) Railey and Carol (Robert) Hatcher; and son-in-law, Johnny Thomas.
