Charles (Chuck) William Kenyon, aged 78, passed away on November 7, 2024, in Tallahassee, FL. Born on February 17, 1946, in Cortland, New York, Chuck spent his early years at Virgil Central School.

Chuck honorably served in the United States Marine Corps, obtaining the rank of Sergeant and serving from 1966 until 1970 during Vietnam. He worked at GreenSouth in Tallahassee and retired after 20 years of service.

Chuck became a born-again Christian in 1983 and served as a member and deacon of Grace Baptist Church of Crawfordville.

Chuck traveled across all 50 states, and spent time hunting, fishing, and camping. He also enjoyed working on tractors and was a fan of Western movies.

Chuck leaves behind his beloved wife of 55 years, Bea Kenyon of Crawfordville, FL; his daughter, Lynne Weybright (Scott); his son, Scott Kenyon (Tammy), both of Tallahassee, FL; and his brother, Larry Kenyon, Sr. of Jasper, FL. He was a proud grandfather to Tim, Chandler, Lilli, and Aubrey Kenyon, and Chelsea (David) Reimert, and great-grandfather to Isabella Weybright, Dylan Bishop and Kimberly Reimert; and several nieces and nephews. Chuck was preceded in death by his parents, Jeston and Ruth Kenyon; his sisters, Virginia Packard and Dorothy Chason; and his brothers, Carl and Richard Kenyon; and grandson, Jason Weybright.
