



## Charles Everett Deal, Sr.

October 4, 1929 - May 28, 2016

Charles Everett Deal Sr. 86, of Crawfordville, died May 28, 2016 at home surrounded by the love of his family after a long fight with a rare form of cancer, peripheral T-cell lymphoma. He was born in Tennessee but spent his entire life in Florida. He was predeceased by his wife of 52 years Peggy Ann Keller Deal. He served his Country as a United States Marine 1952-1954, was a founding member of the Florida Highway Patrol Auxiliary Wakulla Unit, where he retired as a major after 45 years of dedicated volunteer service, a member of the American Legion, had a reputation as an expert Diesel Marine Mechanic well into his 70's and was sought after all along the Forgotten Coast.
