



## Claxton Vause Jr.

April 30, 1933 - May 15, 2024

Claxton Vause, Jr., 91, of Sopchoppy, passed away peacefully at his home with his loving family on May 15, 2024. Claxton was born April 30, 1933, in Arran, Florida, and grew up most of his life in Sopchoppy. He graduated from Sopchoppy High School in 1952. He was a Paratrooper in the United States Army 82nd Airborne Division. Claxton was the Chief of Police in Sopchoppy for 19 years and also was a Wakulla County Sheriff's Deputy for 9 years, where he served as a Bailiff for the Wakulla County Court. He was a member of Sopchoppy Southern Baptist Church and previously served as a Deacon at Sopchoppy First Baptist Church. Claxton taught a Bible Study for 53 years and ministered at the nursing homes & hospitals. Claxton enjoyed bass fishing, attending the Sopchoppy Opry and traveling with his wife in their motor home. He was a true Florida Gator Football fan, but his greatest passion was reading and studying his Bible.

He will be remembered by his wife of 69 years Vonita Vause, daughters Arlene Vause, Danita Pope and husband Jesse & Myra Rogers and husband Richard, 4 step grandchildren Douglas Rogers, Karen Rogers Trumbull (Ethan), Shelly Baksh & Ruben Pope, 9 great grandchildren, sister-in-law Diane Vause and very special friends Tom & Sandy Sheets, who have become part of our family.

Predeceased by his parents Claxton & Marcia Vause, sisters Almyra Mathis & Betsy Vause and brother Pleasant Vause.

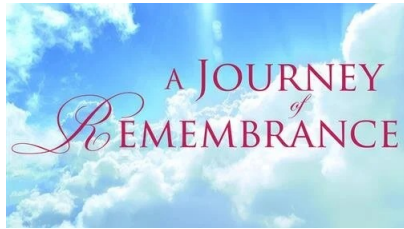
