



Deborah Elaine Bates

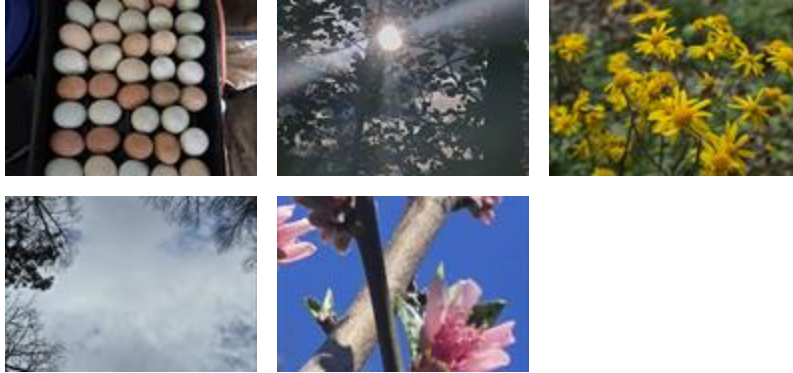
February 11, 1961 - April 20, 2026
