Franklin T. Hardee III, 66, of Crawfordville died at his home January 8, 2016. He moved to Crawfordville from Tallahassee in 1985. He retired from the FSU Police Records Department. He was a United States Army Veteran, serving in the Korean and Viet Nam Wars as a Medic, part of the 101st Airborne, recipient of the Bronze Star and served in the United States Army Reserve until 1983.

He is survived by his daughter Angela Taylor (Tony), son Franklin Hardee IV, granddaughter Hollilyn E. Noe and several loving family members in Georgia.

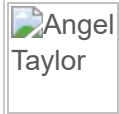

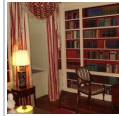
