On April 29th, 1942, John Willie Bergeron (also known to his many friends as "Cajun John" was born to Ludivoc Bergeron and Bertha Breaux. God called his name at the age of 79 on February 23, 2022.

John was born in Louisiana but became a life-long resident of Crawfordville, FL for thirty three (33) years. However, it didn't stop him from doing something else. John tried for the next two years to learn how to cook peanuts until he perfected it.
