December 28, 1926 - December 30, 2015

Joseph W. Tyner , 89, of Crawfordville, died Wednesday, December 30, 2015, after a long illness. He was born December 28, 1926 in Laurel Hill Florida, Okaloosa County to Joseph W. & Maggie Tyner, and was the youngest of 8 children. He served in the United States Navy from December 27, 1944-April 27, 1950. Seaman First Class, V-6, USNR. He was a World War II veteran serving in the Philippines, the Bikini Islands and Nagasaki, Japan, on a mine sweeper and recovery vessels. He was Honorably Discharged with the Bronze Star, 2 Purple Hearts, WW II Victory Medal, American Area Campaign Ribbon, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Ribbon, European African Middle Eastern, Navy Occupation. He served at/and aboard Headquarters Seventh Naval District, USS Delegate (AM217), USS Holland (ARG 18), Naval Air Station Navy #824 KWAJALEIN, Naval Air Station Navy #961, US NAAS Whiting Field Milton, Florida. He married Lena Mae Johnson in Crestview, Florida in 1949. They moved to Tallahassee in 1955 while working for the Florida Forestry Service. In 1965 he began work with Protection Services where he was Branch Manager, until he retired in 1990. He was a Christian and a member at New Hope Christian Center in Havana, Florida. Joseph was known to his family as "J or JW", and to his friends as "Joe". He was a great mechanic and a "jack of all trades". He enjoyed Nascar racing, working on car & boat engines and in his younger years enjoyed training bird dogs, quail hunting, fishing and baseball. He was an avid FSU fan and CB radio operator. He coached Senior Boys and Litwiler League baseball in the 1960's while in

Tallahassee.

He is survived by his wife of 66 years Lena Tyner of Crawfordville, son Jerry Tyner (Audrey) of Crawfordville, daughters Vicki Philyaw (Malvin) of Valdez, North Carolina & Maggie Rose of Crawfordville, brother Paul Tyner of Crestview, 5 grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
