



Larry Noel LaSeur

September 25, 1950 - December 27, 2015

After a long illness Larry Noel LaSeur passed away on December 27, 2015. He was born in Chicago, Illinois, on September 25, 1950, the oldest child of Dr. Noel and Mrs. Frances C. LaSeur.

Larry was a graduate of Florida High class of 1968. Larry worked on FSU's BOMAX Project in Barbados during the summers of 1968 and 1969. He attended Florida State University where he majored in Theater and University of California Santa Cruz where he majored in Theater Production. He moved to New York City where he worked as a roadie for Loggins and Messina, Rick Wakeman, Blue Oyster Cult as well as doing national tours of Broadway shows such as Jesus Christ Superstar, Hair and various other acts. Tiring of life on the road, Larry came back to Tallahassee. He worked for the State of Florida Department of Natural Resources as a surveyor, surveying tidal wetlands throughout Florida. Larry refocused his career on electronics and worked for Data Max, State of Florida Department of Labor and retired from Florida Information Resources Network as a network engineer. Larry enjoyed riding his motorcycles, playing with his kitties and music. He played harps with Carlos and Friends, Charles Atkins and various other bands. His other love was sailing catamarans. He participated in the 1988 Regatta Pointe Stiletto National Championships 30 class and came in 3rd place.

He is survived by Dorothy LaSeur, his wife of seventeen years, his son Patrick, daughter-in-law Jamie LaSeur, daughter Lydia LaSeur, sister Lois LaSeur, his brother-in-law Gordon Clauss and former wife Debralee LaSeur
