Ronald A. Sinclair, age 87, of Cheboygan, Michigan, and most recently Tallahassee, Florida, passed away on January 24, 2026. He was born on February 24, 1938. Ron was preceded in death by his beloved parents, Gordon and Evelyn Sinclair, and his son, Michael Sinclair. He was a strong man, a brave man, and a wise man whose advice, stories, and warm hugs will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him. Ronald A. Sinclair leaves behind a legacy of integrity, generosity, devotion, and love that will continue to guide his family for generations to come.
