Sheryl Ashmore Ferrell, 101, of Crawfordville, passed away peacefully, Saturday, September 23, 2023. Ms. Ferrell was a native and lifelong resident of Wakulla County, living in Smith Creek & Crawfordville. She worked for the Florida State Legislature prior to working as an Assistant for 32 years in the Wakulla County Property Appraisers Office alongside her husband Emmett Clarence Ferrell, Jr. During the war she taught school, teaching English, Latin and then taught the 2nd grade. Ms. Sheryl joined the Crawfordville First Baptist Church when she was 13 and remained a member until her death. She was the Church Clerk for 35 years and taught Sunday School for over 40 years. Ms. Sheryl was a member of the Reaper's Women's Sunday School Class.
