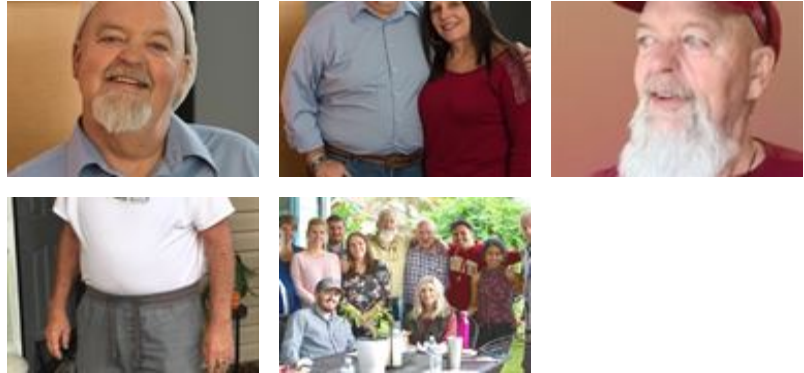

“ Tommy and I held a deep connection that started so many years ago. I think it was the summer of 72 or 73 but seeing how we all were just young and crazy kids who loved to party and have a good time with our friends. One of the favorite spots was Cherokee sink. NOT the one most of you know but the real one back then. I will not even try and tell you all who was there as the place was packed and everyone was having fun, the rope swing was non stop and here comes Tommy who knew this swing very well, drunk and sober, lol he swung out and dropped/dove/flopped and we all yelled and clapped and cheered. Not sure who saw him first and yelled or if they even saw the blood floating above his head that was still under water, Not sure but I think every male jumped in and every female scream or cried out, hugging each other. I said some would not know the old sink because they and messed it up but there was NO EASY out of the sink. Someone yelled his neck is broke so two guys held his head while God only knows how many lifted him up a little at a time. I was close to the area where they were coming up and I reached over and touched him and he put a death grip on my right lower arm, so besides all the guys holding him up they had to pull me right along with them. When they got him up they put him on the closed trunk of a car. A lot of yelling for everyone to shut up and go get help (we did not have cell phones) still two guys holding his neck still and telling him to stay still all along he still had a hold on me and I was talking to him when they wrapped a towel around his head and we tried to dry him off a little but he was still trying to get up. It took a few of the guys to hold him still , I guess he didn't know just how bad he was hurt, because no one ever got hurt at cherokee , well if you got in a fight you would, but never from swinging off the rope. (cutting it short now) again not sure who but they took off in a car to meet the sheriff at the paved road. He ended up in half body halo with rods screwed in his head I ended up with a black and blue arm for a few weeks but it was worth it to know he was gonna make it. And make it back he did, he came back with bigger heart and become one of the big ole teddy bears anywhere. He made sure he bear hugged me tight every time we saw each other. I have loved this whole family for over 60 years and like me we are losing more

and more every day. I will never forget Tommy and never stop loving them all. May God hold all of you that are left. we don't have time to waste on silly things, love you brothers/sisters/kids while they are here to love you back, do not wait till it's late
