William Glen Peel, 48, of Shell Point, died in a diving accident and was lost at sea on June 17, 2017. He was a native of Ft. Walton Beach and moved to Wakulla County 20 years ago. Glen was an avid fisherman, hunter, shooter, loved diving and was a FSU sports fan.

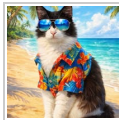
